WALKER BAG

Materials:

¹/₂ Yard Fabric that is 2 sided – heave fabric ie. Canvas, denim, upholstery 1-2 Packages Extra Wide Double-fold Bias Tape

Velcro - 2 pieces 3"x 4"

Cut:

1 rectangle - $18 \frac{1}{2}$ " x 15" (back of bag and fold over flap). Round outer corners 1 rectangle - $10 \frac{1}{2}$ " x 15" (outside pocket, front of bag). Round outer bottom corners 1 rectangle - 5" x 10" (inside pocket – divided)

Sewing:

- 1. Sew bias tape or serge on top of front pocket and inside pocket to finish edge. You can also allow additional fabric and hem tops. This will save on your bias tape.
- 2. Inside Pocket press ¹/₄" under or serge sides and bottom.
- 3. Place and sew ½ Velcro on backside of back of bag. 1 ½" below top edge and 1 ½" in from side edge. Do this on both side edges. Other ½ Velcro 3 ½" below bottom of top Velcro.
- Place inside pocket 1 ¼" above bottom and 2 ½" in from sides of back of bag. Sew sides and bottom. Divide pocket in half or thirds and stitch up from bottom of inside pocket to top of inside pocket. This allows a place for small items of owner.
- 5. Place outside pocket (front of bag) on bottom of back of bag. Stitch the front pocket down. Sew bias tape around outer edge of bag or serge if you like.

Be sure to round corners before putting bias tape on or serging final outer bag. Be sure to place Velcro on backside of bag! Your bag is complete.
