# Walker Bag Instructions - provided by Joanne Woodfill



This simple walker bag is quick to make and much appreciated by the recipients of your generosity.

Here's what you'll need to make the bag:


- Small amounts of fabric cut to the dimensions listed under "cutting fabric"
- 2 yards of webbing for attaching the bag to the walker
- About 4" inches of Velcro for making the webbing straps adjustable
- Small piece of ribbon or cording (for key chain)

### **Cutting Fabric**

- Cut 2 pieces 12 ½" x 14 ½" (these are for the front and back of the bag.
- Cut 1 piece 8 ¾ x 14 ½ (this piece is for the pocket)


### **Making the Pocket**

- 1. Fold over 1/4" along the top edge.
- 2. Turn under again 1" and sew hem in place.
- 3. Pin 12 ½" lengths of webbing down the front of the pocket with outer edges of the webbing 3" from side raw edges.
- 4. Sew webbing from bottom raw edge to turned hem (see illustration below).



#### **Tote Front**

- 1. Fold over 1/4" along the top edge.
- 2. For keychain, fold ribbon/cording in half and baste folded ribbon/cording to turned edge 1 ½" from either side raw edge.
- 3. Fold over again 1 1/4" and sew in place.
- 4. Baste sides and bottom of pocket tote front (see illustration).



- 5. Turn webbing over hem at tote top and sew to hemmed area only.
- Sew 1" Velcro (soft side) to each turned area of web.

#### **Tote Back**

- Turn under ¼" along the top edge.
- Fold over again 1 ¼" and sew in place.
- 3. Pin 23" lengths of webbing 3" from side raw edges (see illustration).
- Sew 1" Velcro (rough side) to each of the outer ends of webbing straps.



# **Finishing**

With right sides together, sew tote front to back. Turn right side out and press.
